

Special Projects: Art's Van Go A \$60,000 NEA Experimental Arts Grant Project – Diagrams posted inside the van

The diagrams on this and on the next page were posted on the back of the Arts and Crafts equipment racks. This diagram detailed the dance floor sections. The second diagram described the loading and unloading procedures, the various ways the floor could be assembled and ways to attach the floor sections to each other.

Dance floor layout format:

L1 Constant Lower Left End Section – a constant.

Section of Floor can only be used on left top edge can be either attached to interchangeable or lower left edge constant.

R1 Constant Lower Left End Section – a constant.

Section of Floor can only be used on right top edge can be either attached to interchangeable or lower left edge constant.

L2 Interchangeable Left Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on left inside.

R2 Interchangeable Right Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on right inside.

L3 Interchangeable Left Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on left inside.

R3 Interchangeable Left Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on right inside.

L4 Interchangeable Left Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on left inside.

R4 Interchangeable Left Section

Section of flooring interchangeable anywhere on right inside.

L5 Lower Left End section - a constant.

Section of Floor can only be used on left top edge can be either attached to interchangeable or lower left edge of top constant.

R5 Lower Right End section - a constant.

Section of Floor can only be used on left lower edge can be either attached to interchangeable or lower left edge of top constant.
